Dear Parents / Carers,

Today has felt very festive. The Christmas music has been playing and the children have spent the afternoon making decorations for the school and the Christmas trees. I love this time of year.

Warwick Castle - Monday 6th December

Year 1 and Year 2 will be visiting Warwick Castle on Monday. Parents of children in those year groups have been sent a separate email with further details about the trip. I am sure they will all have a fantastic time.

Decorate a Cup competition - Monday 6th December

On Monday, all the children will be bringing home a plastic cup so they can take part in our decorate a cup competition. (Year 1 and Year 2 will be given their cups on Tuesday if it becomes too hectic at the end of the trip.) The children have one week to use the cup to make a decoration / ornament that is related to the festive season. We hope the children will be as creative as possible. This will provide a You Tube link so you can view the full version of this year's Christmas production.

At 2.45pm, the KS1 children will make their way out to the top playground. They will then perform a couple of songs from 'It's a Nativity'. They will be performing in front of the PE shed. If you would like to see this 'mini event' please make your way up to the top playground. The gate will be opened at 2.45pm. At the moment the weather forecast looks ok (!) - a bit chilly but no rain. We will only do this mini performance if weather allows.

Christmas Jumper Day - Friday 10th December

This is an opportunity to wear a festive top to school. Nobody is expected to make any kind of financial contribution - just a bit of festive fun.

Cars on site

Please can I remind parents that there is no access for vehicles onto school site before 4.30pm. There are two reasons for this.
